

DIRECTIONS TO CITY & REGIONAL PLANNING PROGRAM OFFICES

ARCHITECTURE-EAST BUILDING – ROOM 204

245 FOURTH STREET, N.W.

GEORGIA TECH CAMPUS

Driving south on I-75/85 into Atlanta:

Take Exit #249D (North Avenue). At the top of the exit ramp, turn right onto North Avenue. Cross Techwood Drive (the first light) and continue on North Avenue to Cherry Street and make a right. Make a left onto Ferst Drive. Follow Ferst to Visitor Parking A03, the first right after the Student Center Parking Deck A02.

Though there are closer parking areas and metered parking on the streets, the Visitor Parking A03 is the most *economical* parking area. You will be provided with a time-stamped parking ticket. If "Lot Full" sign is posted, please try the Student Center Deck A02.

Driving north on I-75/85 into Atlanta:

Take Exit #250 (10th/14th Street). Turn left (west) onto 10th Street at the top of the exit ramp. Continue down 10th Street past Fowler Street and Atlantic Drive, making a left onto State Street. Follow State Street to Ferst Drive. Turn right onto Ferst Drive and continue past the Campus Recreation Center and the light at Means Street. The Visitor Parking A03 should be the first left after the Means Street traffic light and before the Student Center Parking Deck A02.

Though there are closer parking areas and metered parking on the streets, the Visitor Parking A03 is the most *economical* parking area. You will be provided with a time-stamped parking ticket. If "Lot Full" sign is posted, please try the Student Center Deck A02.

After Parking at Visitor Parking A03:

From the parking lot, walk through the Student Center and continue east either along the walkway outdoors or through the Student Center Commons indoors. Follow the walkway around the campanile and diagonally across the grassy area to the point where the road bends 90 degrees and heads east. There is a bench there, and the road name

changes from Atlantic to Fourth Street at that point. Across the street in front of you is the Electrical Engineering building, and just beyond that building, across the parking lot, is Architecture-West building, a three-story concrete and glass structure. Adjoining that building by a walkway on the second floor is Architecture-East, the building where the City & Regional Planning Program is located. Enter Architecture-East through the breezeway in the back of the building. Take the elevator or stairs to the second floor. Room 204 is at the east end of the hallway.

Arriving at Hartsfield Airport:

Cab: Take a cab to 245 Fourth Street, which is half a block west of the intersection of Fowler and Fourth Streets on the Tech campus. Architecture building-East is a red brick building with the word "Architecture" on the front. Enter Architecture-East through the breezeway in the back of the building. Take the elevator or stairs to the second floor. Room 204 is at the east end of the hallway.

MARTA (Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority):

Trains take you from the airport baggage claim to the Midtown station. You can take either the Fare is \$1.75 one way, and exact change or token is required (token machines are available at MARTA stations). It is a 20-minute ride. Exit the station on the Peachtree Place side and wait for the Tech Trolley, a yellow and black trolley which loops between the campus and Midtown station frequently. No fare or ID is required. Exit the trolley at the intersection of Fifth and Fowler Street, and walk south to the end of Fowler Street where it 'T's into Fourth. Turn right on Fourth Street and walk uphill past the fraternity houses. The first office building on the right will be the Architecture-East building. Enter Architecture-East through the breezeway in the back of the building. Take the elevator or stairs to the second floor. Room 204 is at the east end of the hallway.
